PRECAUTIONS:

- Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing
- Wear protective clothing such as apron, gloves, facemask and boots during application and handling of the pesticide.
- Do not eat, drink, chew tobacco or smoke during application.
- Bathe or shower after spraying and change to clean clothes.

FIRST AID MEASURES:

Ingestion: If swallowed, induce vomiting and repeat till the fluid is clear. Give gastric lavage with 5% sodium bicarbonate solution, if necessary.

Skin Contamination: In case of contact, immediately wash skin with soap and plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ANTIDOTE:

- Inject atropine sulphate 2 to 4 mg and repeat every 5-10 minutes till fully atropinised.
- Administer 1-2 g of 2-PAM dissolved in 10 cc of distilled water and inject intravenously, very slowly for 10-15 minutes.
- If necessary, give artificial respiration.
- Diagnosis can be confirmed by estimating cholinesterase activity of blood.

STORAGE:

- Store in original containers in a separate room or almirah
- Store away from food and feed stuffs under lock and key
- Keep out of reach of children and domestic animals or household pets
- Store in a cool, dry, well built and well lit place of sufficient dimensions with good ventilation.

DISPOSAL OF EMPTY CONTAINERS:

- Never re-use the empty containers
- Destroy and bury in a safe place
- Dispose off packages or surplus material in a safe manner to prevent environmental and water pollution.
